### UGC-NRC Hostel

#### Guidelines for providing routine catering service to non-inmates

1. Catering service provided for non-inmates should in no way interfere with the regular service provided to the Hostel inmates.
2. Regular breakfast, lunch and dinner are provided at the rates shown in the relevant link ([Menu Cost](#)).
3. **A maximum of 125** breakfasts/lunches/dinners will be served at any time; this will include the number of inmates of the Hostel as well.
4. Booking with payment should be done between **9:00 – 11:00 am** at the desk provided near the outside entry of the Dining Hall. **No query will be entertained by the offices of the UGC-NRC, the Coordinator or the Dean, School of Chemistry.**
5. Identity of the customer (valid UGC-NRC or University ID) will be verified by the Hostel Supervisor; following his approval, the Catering Agency will issue the appropriate food coupon, collect payment and issue valid receipt. Only one coupon will be issued against one identity card.
6. The current timings for dining are :
  - Breakfast (8:00 – 9:00 am)
  - Lunch (1:00 – 2:00 pm)
  - Dinner (8:00 – 9:00 pm)
